The INVEST in Her TVET Scholarship Programme provides full and partial scholarships to young females interested in Technical Skills Training in male dominated trades/occupations, to enhance their employability and economic opportunities. Apprenticeship training opportunities ranging from 3 - 12 months in length are available at eligible TVET Training Institutions, Enterprises and Mastercraft persons workshops.

Eligibility Criteria

- Young Women between the ages of 15-35 years
- Resident of a marginalised community within Greater Accra (Accra & Tema), Ashanti Region (Greater Kumasi) and Western Region (Sekondi-Takoradi)
- Ability to read and write
- Proximity to an eligible training provider
- Willingness and desire to learn a Technical Skill in a male-dominated trade
- Ability to commit to full training duration (3-12 months depending on trade area)

Application Process

1. Access the electronic **or** hardcopy scholarship application at www.theinvestproject.com, a WUSC office/ GhCCI office (Accra, Kumasi, Takoradi) or any eligible Training Provider indicated above
2. Contact the chosen Training Institution for the courses offered
3. Read instructions carefully before submitting your application
4. Completed application forms should be submitted to the Training Institution you selected or to a WUSC/GhCCI project office (Accra, Kumasi or Takoradi)
5. Only appropriately submitted and complete applications will be considered
